

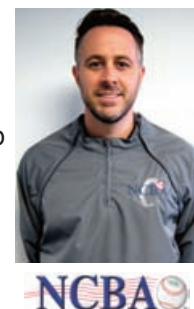

Josh Knight Named NCBBA Ntn'I Championship MVP



Virginia Tech was lead by their point guard, Joshua Knight. Knight carried his team in the National Championship game with a game high 24 points. Knight shot a solid 57% from the field and went 8 for 10 at the free throw line to ice the game for the Hokies. Knight displayed blazing quickness combined with shifty moves and passes throughout the tournament.



He was named the Most Valuable Player of the tournament and was honored after the game with a NCBBA plaque.

Hokies Upset Spring Hill to Claim Inaugural NCBBA National Championship

The first NCBBA National Championship Tournament was a huge success. The teams that traveled to Pittsburgh to compete in the tournament played every game at a high level. Lewis University, Spring Hill College, West Virginia University, the University of Connecticut, and Virginia Tech University all had great showings in the tournament.



Sunday was the day we waited for all season long - the NCBBA National Championship game. The Virginia Tech Hokies vs. the Spring Hill College Badgers competing for a chance to be crowned National Champions. The much anticipated game tipped-off at 4:30 pm.

Both teams came out of the gate flying, with a high-paced action packed first half. At halftime Virginia Tech went into the locker room with a 44-33 lead. Spring Hill made the necessary adjustments and were not going to go away easy. Virginia Tech outlasted Spring Hill's valiant second half effort and held on to win a pressure packed and intense game by a final score of 81-73, and were crowned NCBBA National Champions.

A big 'Thank You' goes out to Andy Bott, Chase Rowe, Jimmy Finley and the entire athletics staff at LaRoche College as well as all of the teams that competed in the inaugural championship event.
