2011 Season Outlook: For us the same as last season, we have to wait and see what the new people look like. We go into 2011 with no proven QB. Kicking should be solid. Last season we began with only nine linemen leaving us with no depth when injury took down several. Injury took out three who got little more than three games each. We did add one but he too was injured. We've a good stable of running backs, several good receivers. If all players return that we have projected, then our secondary should be solid with some depth. We had several veteran players last fall unable to participate due to jobs, class conflicts, or grade problems. Of the four in that category we expect one or two back. So, we have to say that we are again looking to rebuild. Everyone who played on offense will be one more year more familiar with the new system Oj has put in. Last year some promising drives were snuffed out by blown assignments or receivers in the wrong place. Alana Dvorak is the most experienced starter at wide out. A good receiver is Sean Zmijewski but he also paly's defense as is Richard North. We will have a core group of running backs returning. Derrick Garrett, TC Haubold, Max Sterling and Andrew Moore are more than adequate at FB. Jon Dennard, Kilbert Scoulars, and Bryon Patton form a solid set of TB's. On the O - line we do have an All - Conference center, Kamari Daniels, returning and a couple of good tight ends, Sam Perkins and Cody Johnson. We only have two guards, Victor Tate and Travis LaJoie. One Tackle returns, Joel Denis. On the defensive side we have several good line backers who may be coming back: Richard North, Sean Zmijewski, TC Haubold, Andre Moore, Max Sterling, Chad Spenski, and Travis LaJoie. With three solid corners, Russ Holler, Richard North, and four people to play the safety positions, Jon Dennard, Aaron Otenaika, Josh Broach and LinQuan Jones. We should be good there. Nikko Carlson and Kristopher Nordein return at DE, as well as NG Jamal Francis.

Last season we were really blown out of only one game, that against a D III JV team. We were in it to the end but depth caught up with us. We split with a prep club, losing the opening game meeting due to blown assignments and lack of offensive production from our new offense. The next one we won by two scores. Our other non-conference game was a six point loss. We just didn't have the depth and experience on offense last year, but offence should be an improved area for us provided we have a signal caller come out.
