## 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual NCFA National Championship Bowl Game Set for December 7<sup>th</sup>

**Pittsburgh, PA** – The National Club Football Association is happy to announce that the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual National Championship Bowl Game will begin at 6 p.m. on Saturday, December 7<sup>th</sup> at Salem Stadium in Salem, Virginia.

The game will feature the two highest ranked NCFA Teams as decided by the Rawlings Power Rankings at the end of the regular season. The winner will be crowned the 2013 NCFA National Champion.

Salem Stadium will play host to this championship event for the second consecutive season. Last year, Coppin State defeated Miami University by a score of 41-17 to take home the championship trophy.

The facility is also the home of the NCAA Division III National Championship, better known as the Amos Alonzo Stagg Bowl, and the Summer Music Games of Southwest Virginia. The stadium seats 7,157 people and is truly a beautiful venue that any collegiate football fan can admire.
