NCSA League Meeting Voting Ballot Results

The ballots are in and the votes have been counted! As a result of the 2014 League Meeting, the NCSA will be amending two current rules and adding two completely new rules to the NCSA Rulebook for the upcoming 2014-15 season. That finalized rulebook will be released before the end of July.

The two rules that were voted to be amended are Rule 13.02.1 and Rule 18.02.0. The two new rules that will be added concern forfeited games and roster violations, and have been voted into place in hopes of keeping NCSA Teams accountable in future seasons.
