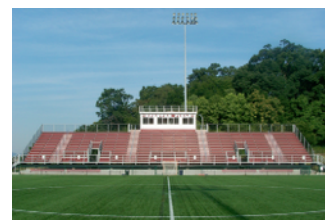
NCFA Postseason Hosted by Salem
