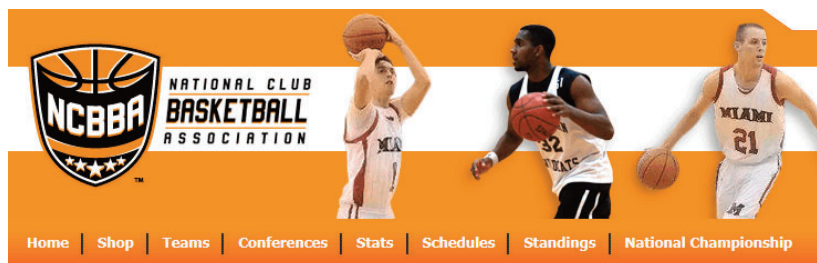

DII Heads Back to Brooks

The NCBA will return to Paducah, Kentucky for another year and Brooks Stadium will once again play host to the Division II World Series. The event will start on May 16th, 2014 with the Championship Game concluding the tournament on the 20th.



“My initial response to the location of the DII World Series was, ‘Where is that?’” said former Kennesaw State DII Coach John Brinson. “To our pleasant surprise, the town was actually quite vibrant - Brooks Stadium was great as well. The grounds were always well-kept, and the crew always great. Teams will be hard pressed to find a city more hospitable towards their respective teams than Paducah.”
