Coppin State Claims Second-Consecutive NCFA Championship



They knew it wasn't going to be easy, but the Eagles from Coppin State had said it all along. They weren't going to leave Salem, VA without a trophy.

No. 2 Coppin State defeated top-ranked and unbeaten Middle Georgia State by a score of 38-13 on Saturday, December 7th to take home its second consecutive NCFA National Championship title.

Sophomore running-back Gavin Hux was named the 2013 NCFA Bowl Game MVP award for his stellar game on the ground. After the game, Eagles' head coach Albert Howard said that winning the league championship two years in a row was a great feeling.

"It's almost like a miracle this time," said Coach Howard. "But our guys deserved it because they just played better football tonight."

Here's a list of things to keep in mind as you prepare:

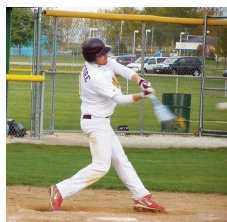
- **Game/Practice Fees:** Due no later than January 31st!
