2013 NCFA Championship Bowl Game Ejection Summary

The following is a summary of the players ejected from the 2014 NCFA National Championship Bowl Game, the reason for their ejection, and any further disciplinary action being taken against each player.

- 1) Nicholas Styles – Coppin State – Ejected for participating in a fight or altercation. – 1st ejection of the 2013 NCFA Season – Will be suspended for the next NCFA Sanctioned Football Game in which he is eligible to compete in. Future ejections for this reason may result in even harsher disciplinary action.
- 2) Delontia Bruton – Coppin State – Ejected for use of foul language/bench jockeying. – 1st ejection of the 2013 NCFA Season – No additional suspension will be administered. Future ejections for this reason may result in disciplinary action.
- 3) Jamal Freeman – Middle Georgia State – Ejected for use of foul language/bench jockeying. – 1st ejection of the 2013 NCFA Season – No additional suspension will be administered. Future ejections for this reason may result in disciplinary action.
- 4) Quez Mahogany – Middle Georgia State – Ejected for participating in a fight or altercation. – 1st ejection of the 2013 NCFA Season – Will be suspended for the next NCFA Sanctioned Football Game in which he is eligible to compete in. Future ejections for this reason may result in even harsher disciplinary action.
- 5) Ken Hughes – Middle Georgia State – Ejected automatically for receiving a 2nd unsportsmanlike conduct penalty in the game. – 1st ejection of the 2013 NCFA Season – No additional suspension will be administered. Future ejections for this reason may result in disciplinary action.
- 6) Arrico Ogletree – Middle Georgia State – Ejected for participating in a fight or altercation. – 1st ejection of the 2013 NCFA Season – Will be suspended for the next TWO NCFA Sanctioned Football Games in which he is eligible to compete in. The additional game suspension is based upon the premeditated and violent nature in which he ran down a Coppin State player and body slammed him to the turf from behind. Future ejections for this reason may result in even harsher disciplinary action.
